Restorative approaches build **strong, respectful, conciliatory** school communities, addressing issues related to behaviour, **relationship-building** and **social skills**. Children develop **emotional literacy** and skills which enable **ownership** of issues and solutions, and this contributes to a culture of **resilience, empowerment** and **concern for others**. Improved quality of relationships **enhances learning** within the classroom.
