Restorative Approaches build strong, respectful, conciliatory school communities, addressing issues related to behaviour, relationship-building and social skills. Improved quality of relationships enhances learning within the classroom.

Training, Services and Support:

Restorative Now work with the Senior Leadership Team to plan a strategy involving training, process design and coaching support, to ensure effective implementation of a Restorative Approach.

Restorative Approaches training is offered by way of:



- **One Day INSET** to all school staff. (Available also is a 3 day Facilitator training for a selection of school staff from across the school cluster.)
- Additional **half-day workshops** available to staff from specific areas, such as break time and lunch time supervisors.
- School assemblies addressing the Restorative Approach introduce the concept to students.
- Training for **Peer Mentors** and Key Stage Restorative Approaches workshops across class groups.
- Meetings with **Parents and Governors** also allow for discussion and awareness raising.
