Restorative Approaches build **strong, respectful, conciliatory** school communities, addressing issues related to behaviour, **relationship-building** and **social skills**. Young people develop **emotional literacy** and skills which enable **ownership** of issues and solutions, and this contributes to a culture of **resilience, empowerment** and **concern for others**. Improved quality of relationships **enhances learning** within the classroom.

Training, Services and Support:

- **One Day INSET** to all school staff. (Available also is a 3 day Facilitator training for a selection of school staff from across the school cluster.)
- Additional **half-day workshops** available to staff from specific areas, such as break time and lunch time supervisors.
- **School assemblies** addressing the Restorative Approach introduce the concept to students.
- Training for **Peer Mentors** and Key Stage Restorative Approaches workshops across class groups.
- Meetings with **Parents and Governors** also allow for discussion and awareness raising.
